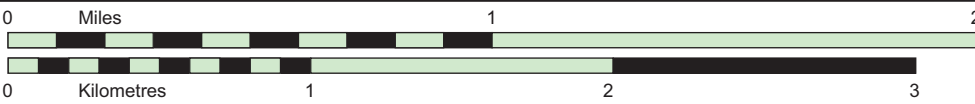


# st132 Dumyat from Bridge of Allan

Bridge of Allan in on the A91 Stirling to Tillicoultry Road. Logie Kirk is just off the B998 at Bridge of Allan



The walk shown is for guidance only and should not be attempted without suitable maps.

The Session Clerk at Logie Kirk has kindly asked for walkers not to use the Logie Kirk car park on Sundays (when the church is being used) but to park in the lane on the south side of the B998.

Thanks for helping out with this so the car park can remain open & available for all on the other days of the week.

## Superb views in all directions

**S** Go NE (right) from the car park on a track between the church & the old graveyard (left) & the new graveyard (right) & into Yellowcraig wood. At a fork go NW (left) to climb steeply up through the trees (following the line of the power lines) to reach a junction. (¾ km)

① Go N (right) & then fork right again to go ESE up through the trees. At a fork (rock, white arrow) bear E (left) and stay with the path as it meanders right & left to reach a fence stile on the edge of Yellowcraig Wood. (½ km)

② Cross and go NE (straight-on) on a clear undulating path across the open hillside. Bear E (half-right) at a major path junction past Castle Law to reach a stile over a fence. Cross and continue SE & E up to the summit of Dumyat (trig point, beacon, memorial). (1¼ km)

③ Continue E, descending a clear grass path steeply down the other side before bearing SE down to reach a stony track (just beyond a large concrete block and a fenced-off area owned by the local council). (1¼ km)

④ Go N (left) gently up the track and follow it as it ascends gently above Menstrie Glen & bears NW to reach a junction. (2¼ km)

⑤ Continue NW (left) past Lossburn Reservoir & then beside a wood to reach a road. (1¼ km)

⑥ Go SW (left) on the road past Cocksburn Wood before descending to a T-junction. (2 km)

⑦ Go SE (left) down the road & follow it when it bears SSE (right) & meanders down through Hermitage Woods to return to Logie Kirk and the car park. (1¼ km)

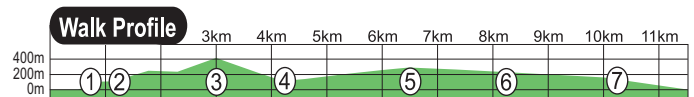
