

hf142 Weobley from Dilwyn

Dilwyn is just off the A4112 Leominster to Brecon Road

The walk shown is for guidance only and should not be attempted without suitable maps.

Gentle stroll on quiet lanes

S Go S from Dilwyn Church and then E (left) at the village green. At the next junction go S for 300m before going SE (left) on a signed footpath. This well signed path follows the edge of the 1st field before crossing a 2nd. Follow a field edge S to a footbridge before bearing half-right across the next field (aim for a telegraph pole) to a stile in a hedge. Continue S across the next field and then a narrow overgrown section before going straight across a cultivated field to reach a lane. (2km)

① Go SW (right) on the lane to reach a junction. Continue SW (straight-on) to reach a second junction. Go S (left) and follow the road through Weobley Marsh to reach a fork just beyond Ledgemoor. (3¹/₂ km)

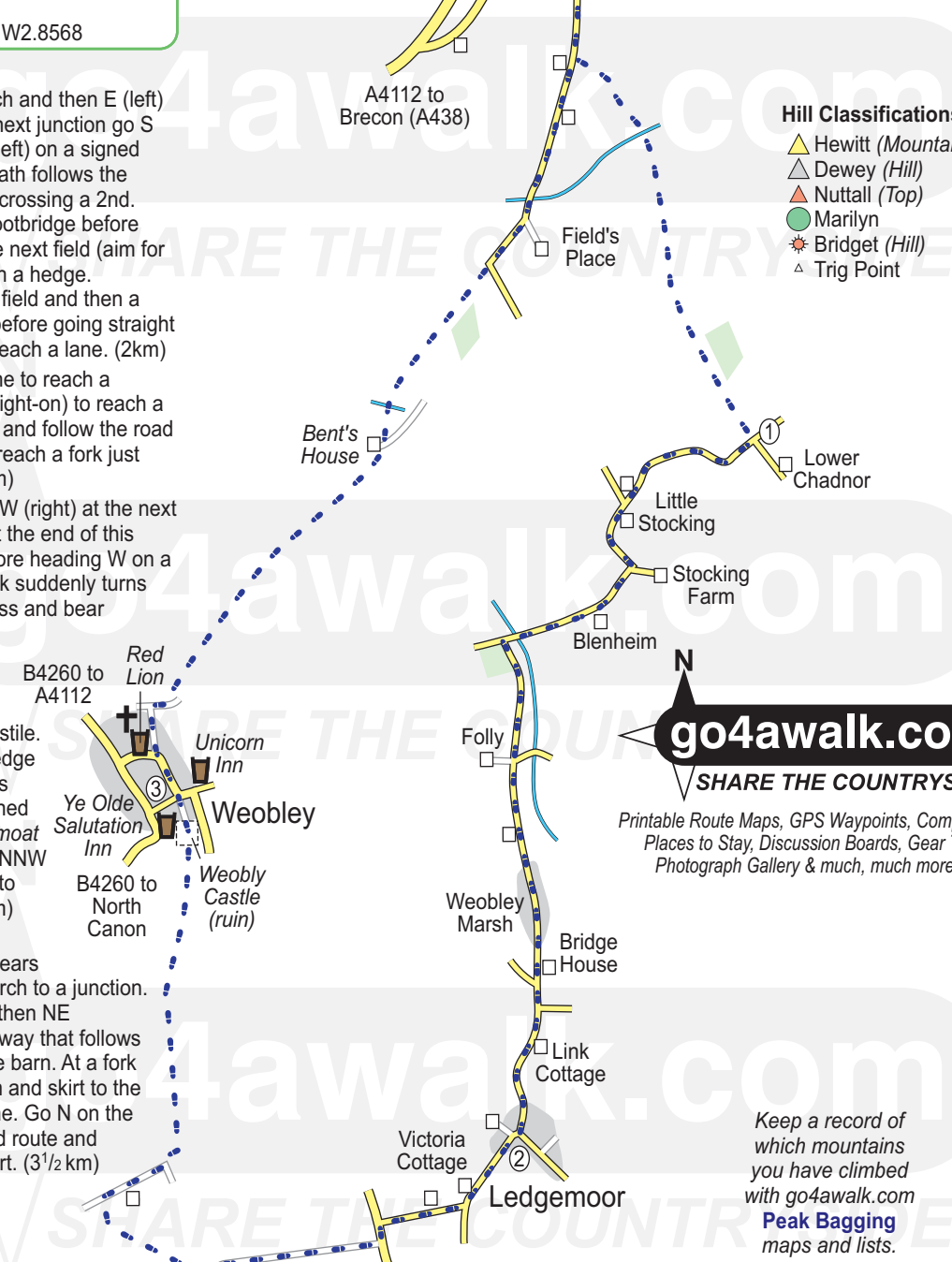
② Go SW (right) and then W (right) at the next junction. At the T-junction at the end of this road go S (left) for 10m before heading W on a signed track. When the track suddenly turns S continue W to a stile. Cross and bear NW across a field to reach a track via a kissing gate. Go E (right) on the track past a house before going N (left) over a stile. Continue E along the field edge to a gate. Go N across fields bearing NE to reach the ruined Weobly Castle (the former moat is clearly visible). Continue NNW through the castle grounds to emerge in Weobley. (3¹/₂ km)

③ Continue N through the village until the main road bears W. Continue N past the church to a junction. Go E (right) on a track and then NE (half-left) on a signed bridleway that follows field edges to reach a single barn. At a fork go N (left) to cross a stream and skirt to the left of a wood to reach a lane. Go N on the lane to pick up your outward route and return to Dilwyn and the start. (3¹/₂ km)
