Bardney is on the B1190 Lincoln to Horncastle Road

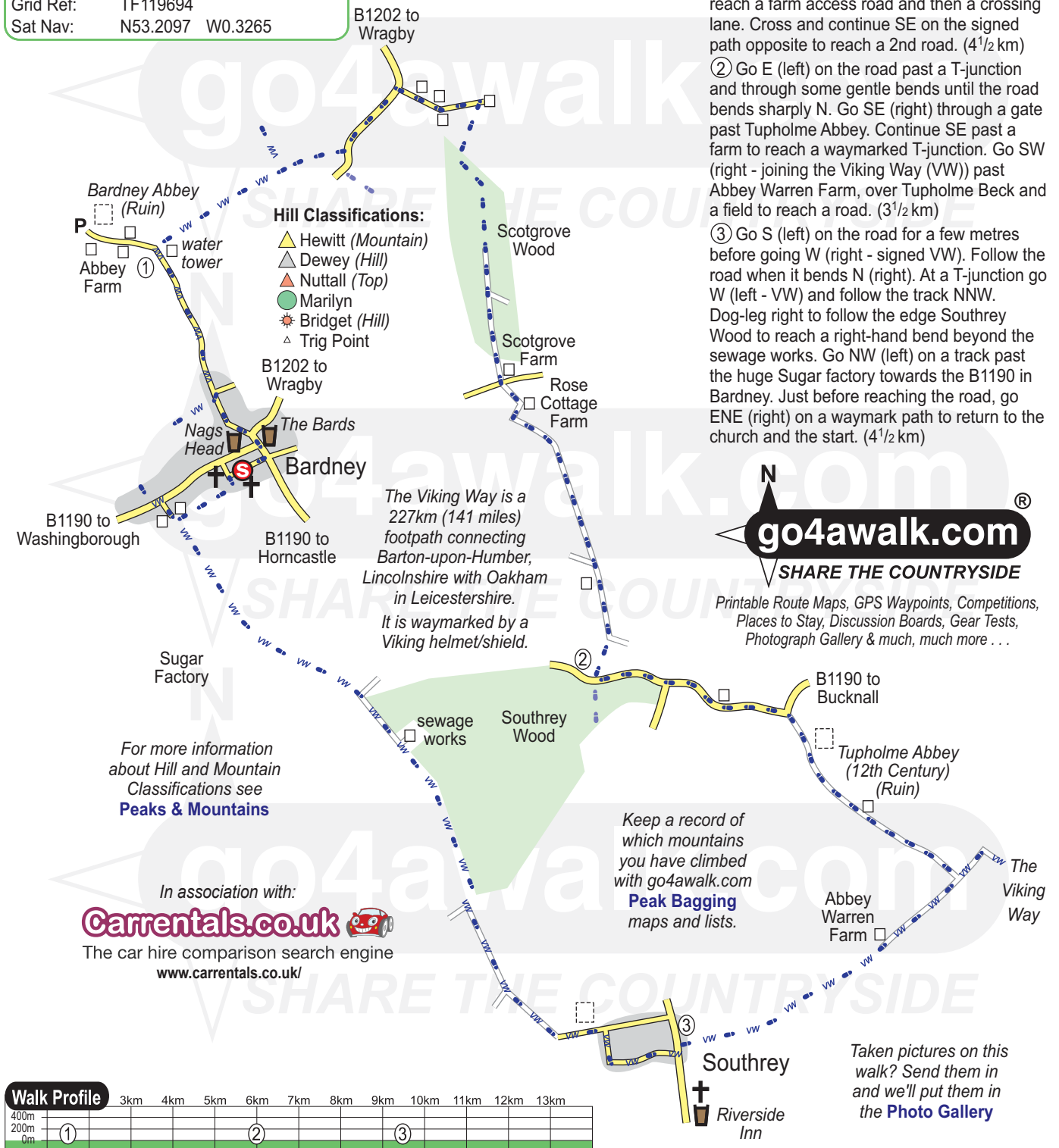
The walk shown is for guidance only and should not be attempted without suitable maps.

Quiet lanes and paths

S Go NE from the church to reach the B1190. Go NW (left) to T-junction. Continue NW and then W into Abbey Road (signed 'Bardney Abbey (site)'). Follow the lane NW on to reach a gate signed 'Abbey Farm'. *If you wish to visit the ruins of Bardney Abbey go W on the lane past two houses and the farm. (1¹/₂ km)*

- Go ENE (right) on a signed bridleway to reach the B1202. Go NE (left) on the road until it bends N. Go E on Youngwood past several houses to reach a partially hidden waymark just before a white cottage. Go S along a field edge and then into Scotgrove Wood. Follow an intermittent path, initially along the wood edge and then S through the trees on an improving track. Continue S (keeping S (right) at a fork) to reach a farm access road and then a crossing lane. Cross and continue SE on the signed path opposite to reach a 2nd road. (4¹/₂ km)
- Go E (left) on the road past a T-junction and through some gentle bends until the road bends sharply N. Go SE (right) through a gate past Tupholme Abbey. Continue SE past a farm to reach a waymarked T-junction. Go SW (right - joining the Viking Way (VW)) past Abbey Warren Farm, over Tupholme Beck and a field to reach a road. (3¹/₂ km)
- Go S (left) on the road for a few metres before going W (right - signed VW). Follow the road when it bends N (right). At a T-junction go W (left - VW) and follow the track NNW. Dog-leg right to follow the edge Southrey Wood to reach a right-hand bend beyond the sewage works. Go NW (left) on a track past the huge Sugar factory towards the B1190 in Bardney. Just before reaching the road, go ENE (right) on a waymark path to return to the church and the start. (4¹/₂ km)

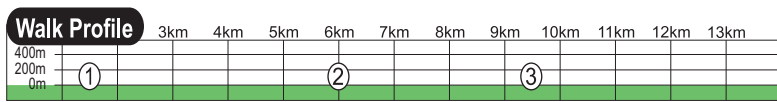
