### Family walk with good views

**S** With your back to the Cenotaph in the centre of Bolsover go WNW (left) on Castle St for 150m to reach the gates of Bolsover Castle. Follow the road SW (left) past a school to reach a junction. Continue SW (straight-on) steeply down Castle Lane until it bends NW (right). (1/4 km)

① Go SE (left) on a signed footpath past the remains of Conduit Houses to reach a junction. Go SW (right) down a footpath to reach a road. Cross & continue SW down the path opposite to emerge on a 2nd road. Cross & continue SW down Dumbles Road. When the road bends SE (left) continue SW on a footpath to reach a crossing track. (3/4 km)

② Go NW (right) past a new housing estate & then SW on Spence St to reach a T-junction. Go S (left) on Main St & continue S as it narrows & curves W to reach a fishing lake. Continue W past the lake (on your left) to reach 'The Stockley Trail', a former railway line. (1 km)

③ Go S (left) & follow the trail to reach a road. Cross & continue S on the trail for 500m, past one signed path crossing to reach a 2nd path crossing marked by unnamed finger posts. (1 km)

④ Go E (left) over a stile & follow the well marked path up the hill towards Palterton. As you approach the village cross a rough track before climbing steeply up a bank to reach a road. (1 1/2 km)

⑤ Go N (left) on the road until it bends & descends NW (left). Leave the road & continue N through a gate & across fields to reach the main road in Hillstown. (1 1/2 km)

⑥ Go NW (left) on the road past New Station Road to reach a park on your right. Go N through the park follow the earthworks on the right-hand edge to reach a traffic lighted crossroads. (1/2 km)

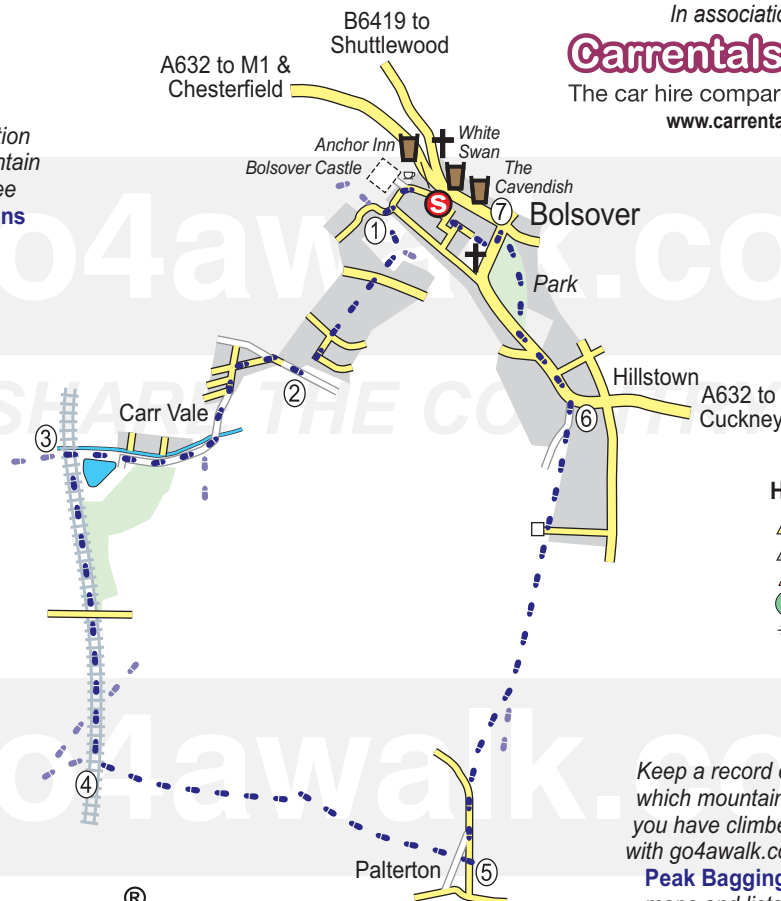
⑦ Go S (left) on Hornscroft Road & then NW (right) on a signed path through the graveyard of a St Mary's & St Laurence Church & then on Church St past the library before going through a brick arch to return to the Bolsover Cenotaph & the start. (1/2 km)

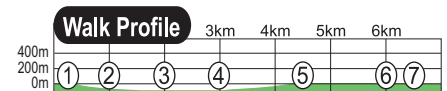
