Hawnby is on minor roads W of the B1257 Helmsley to Stokesley Road

Pleasant country stroll

① Go W on the road through Hawnby village before going NW (right) on a signed track opposite Manor Farm. Climb gently up the track that slowly bears N past Hill End House and then a gate. Continue N on the track until it beand right. Leave and continue NNE (straight-on) towards Bilsdale TV Mast to reach a road at Moor Gate. (2km)

② Don't go through the gate but bear E (left) with the wall on your right to follow a clear path that heads E and then S before continuing SE round the base of Easterside Hill. Ignore a stile on your right and continue beside the wall/fence (still on your right) to descend to a road. (1½ km)

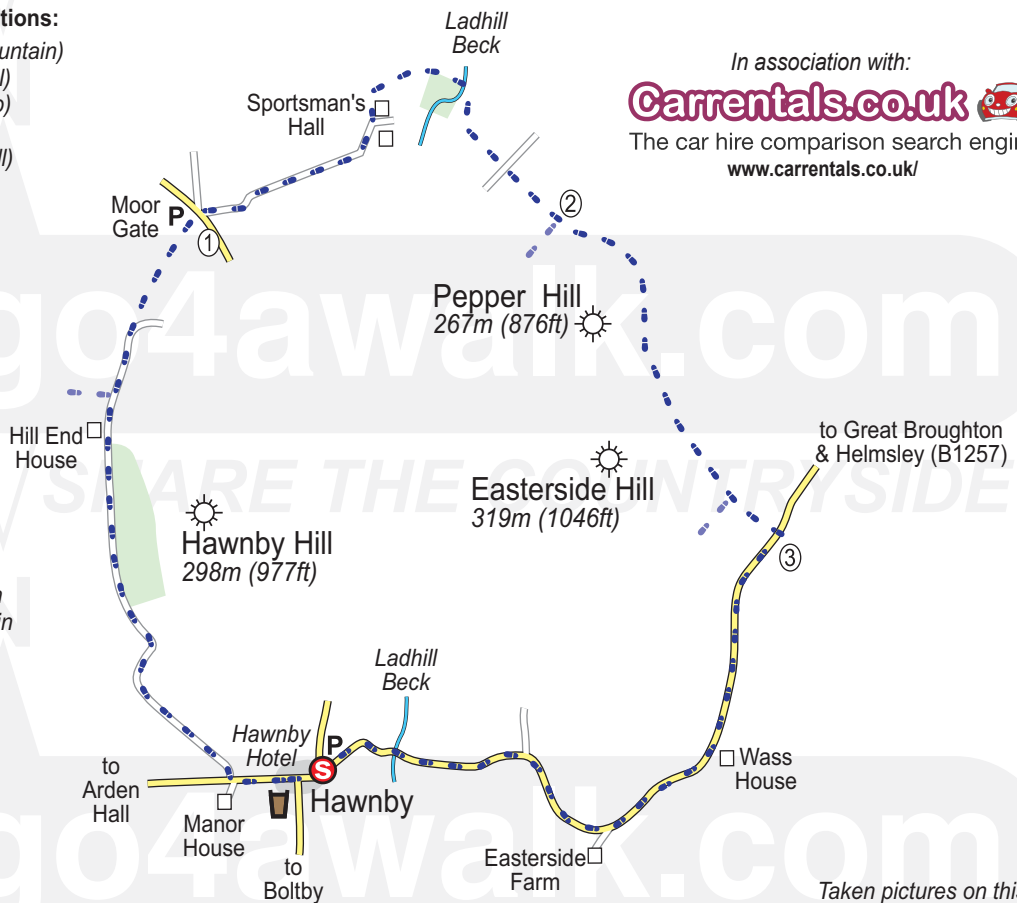
③ Go S (right) on the road and follow it when it bears W back to Hawnby and the start. (2½ km)
